Our Story

In early January of 2016 the Gary Borger Chapter of Trout Unlimited met to discuss the potential of sponsoring a Project Healing Waters Fly Fishing Program with the Captain James A Lovell Federal Health Center in North Chicago and supported by Holy Cross Lutheran Church in Libertyville, Illiois. A Steering Committee was formed to begin outlining the program. In Mid-February, the application was submitted and approved by Project Healing Waters Fly Fishing and our program was named Project Healing Waters Fly Fishing (PHWFF) - North Chicago, part of the Midwest Region. The Steering Committee developed a program schedule and concepts for how our volunteers will be trained and how we will interact with the veterans.

As it is our first year of operation, the steering committee agreed that the program will continue to grow and evolve and that it is important to continuously evaluate what works, and, what needs improvement, in an effort make this program interesting and fulfilling for both the veterans and volunteers. We will accomplish this through conducting team Pull Up Sessions after each volunteer training or veteran program session. At these Pull Up Sessions, we will ask for input by the team to help us evolve the program to advance North Chicago to it's most effective potential. ....to learn as we teach and teach as we learn....


....to appreciate small steps....and....

....Knowing that this program will operate year round, it is important to provide team depth to cover for the times some of our mentors can't be there....

....We are reasonably certain that we will outnumber the veterans initially....that's the optimal position to be in....

....When possible, we will strive to pair mentors and veterans in a manner that promotes a consistent relationship....


....To build that team depth, Team TU, as technical advisors, is committed to train members of Team Holy Cross and Team Lovell to assist in mentoring and ultimately teaching fly fishing skills....

....While this won't happen over night, the benefits will be rewarding as we watch this team grow, having FUN along the way....

....let's look at how we apply this strategy....



....If we use fly tying as an example....



....At every Skill Station there will be a Lead Instructor....This will be a Team TU Member....they may or may not provide individual instruction....

....Team TU could also provide an Assistant Instructor who can walk around the stations and offer on-the-spot assistance....
....Depending on the numbers, there may not be a TU Mentor for every veteran....that's where the Assistant comes in....the goal would be to coach up all volunteers so that in the future there is less dependence on TU Mentors and less distinction between mentors in general....


....As the program evolves, this arrangement supports varying skill levels in the veterans....

....The Program Lead (PL) and the Assistant Program Lead (APL) will "work the room" to monitor interactions....

....so our next step is to look at it all together....



....Here's how the stations work....




....All sessions will begin with Hospitality....This allows for some bonding time and time for the veterans to decompress....This station could also support an educational component like instructional or conservation videos....In an effort to "test" our program early on, we will be running our volunteer training sessions just like we would run our program for the veterans....This gives us a chance to simulate the experience and make improvements before we have our first interaction with the veterans.... In order to provide an experience with more variety, the room will be set up in "stations" where the trainees will have the opportunity to move from station to station relative to their interest or energy level....

....now we can look at how this plays out over time....




....Here's how we ramp up the year and beyond....


